Mayor Dick Galbraith welcomed those present to the meeting.

Discuss / Consider Contracting for Emergency Repairs for Sewer Line Break
– ACTION ITEM

Wastewater Division Head Brian Vail provided an update on the sewer line break on S Street to those in attendance. Mr. Vail reported that he had solicited bids from three contractors for the replacement of approximately 215 feet of sewer pipe and received two quotes back. Mr. Vail confirmed the city has the necessary pipe in stock, bids were solicited for the mobilization, pipe installation, connections to the existing manholes, and re-establishment of sewer services.

City Engineer Ivan McCracken stated the current 8-inch concrete sewer main is old and has deteriorated to the point of structural failure. Mr. McCracken noted that the city was aware of the pipe's condition and that it was scheduled for replacement as part of the Wastewater Collection System Master Plan. The plan called for the pipe to be deepened and upsized to a 21-inch pipe.

Mr. McCracken stated in the future, there may be additional upgrades to the pipe size and depth of the line in this location, which will replace the current line.

Motion by Joanne Justesen to approve the sewer line emergency repair work contracting with Waltons Inc. for the bid amount of \$15,440 as presented. Second by Rose Schmitt. Roll-Call Vote: Chad Anderson – Aye; Joanne Justesen – Aye; Rose Schmitt – Aye.
