Discussion on Equivalent Dwelling Units and Sand-Points

City Engineer Ivan McCracken provided a summary of potential equivalent dwelling units to those present. Mr. McCracken explained that there may be issues with water rights and using subwater/perched aquifer that could cause staff to have to re-consider the sand-point irrigation solution.

Discussion on Riverside Park Walking Path along Blue River Estates Subdivision

City Engineer Ivan McCracken and Parks Department Head Jose Paz provided those present with an update on the Riverside Park Walking Path along Blue River Estates Subdivision. Mr. Paz stated part of the walking path was built years ago on Blue River Estates property and needs re-located to the city's property. Mr. Paz stated for the time being a dirt path has been created to complete the path and allow residents to continue to use the walking path.

City Engineer Ivan McCracken and City Administrator Tony Morley provided those present with updates on the Gem Grant, Riverbank Stabilization Grant, School Walking Path Grant, and Master Transportation Plan Grant. Those present also discussed future grant opportunities.
